



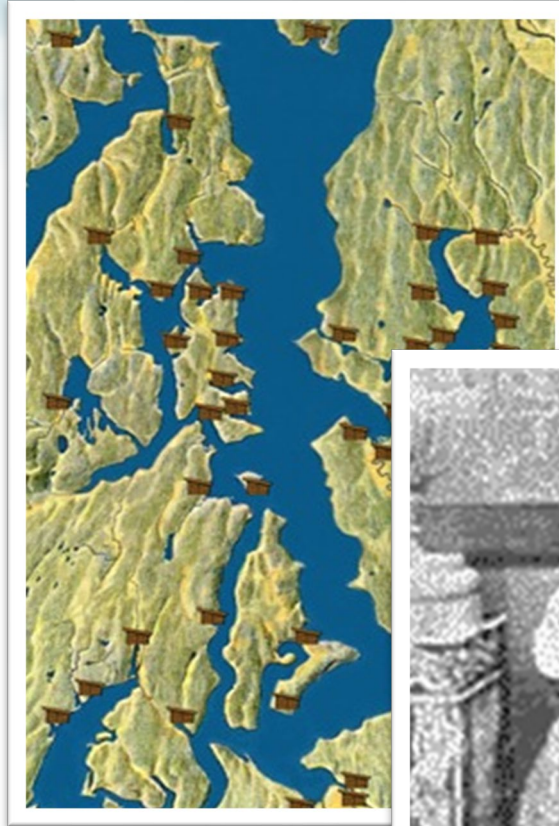

Suquamish Tribe

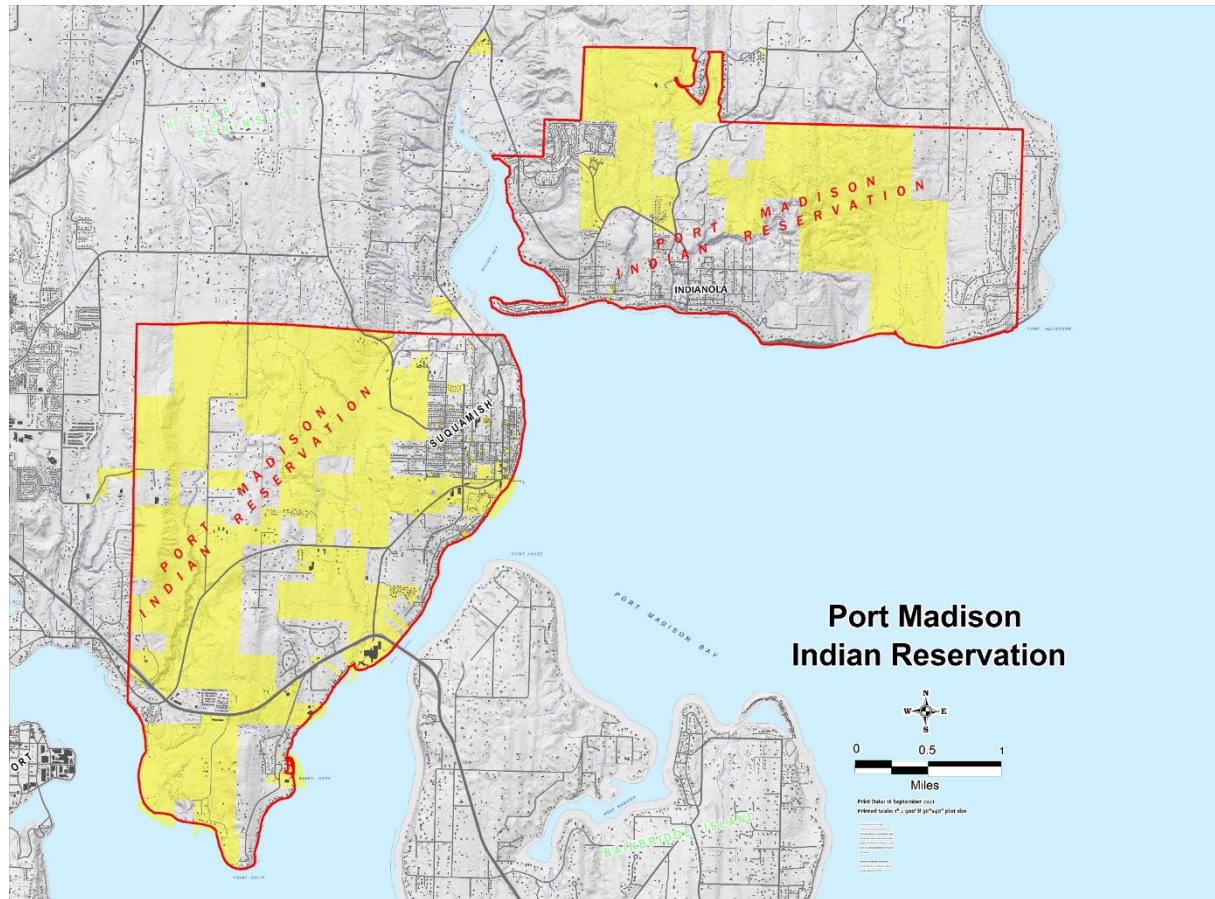
- Suquamish people have lived in Puget Sound for at least 10,000 years.
- Archeological sites include Port Orchard, Bremerton and Suquamish.
- Places named for Suquamish leaders include Seattle, Kitsap and Chico.
- Today there are a total of 1,241 Tribal Members.



Suquamish Reservation

A total of 7,602 acres

- Suquamish Tribal Government and PME: 1,491 acres
- Individual Tribal Members: 2,579 acres
- Non-Tribal owners: 3,532 acres

Suquamish Tribal Government

- Governed by 7-member Tribal Council, elected by membership
- Formal government relationships at federal, state, county, and municipal levels

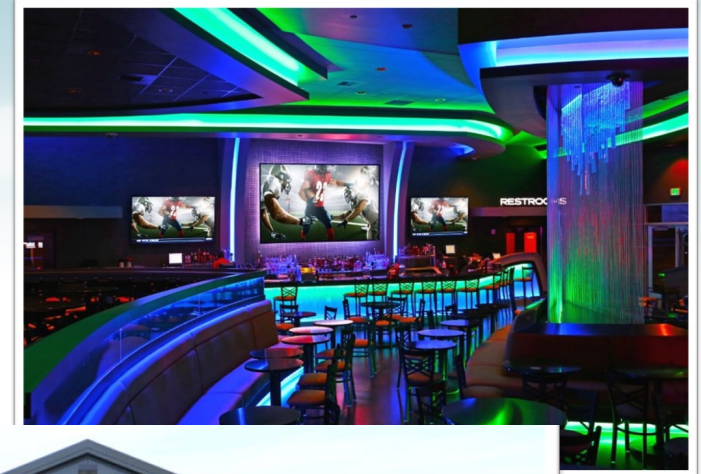
